## Northbury Cemetery

(Now PLYMOUTH)

*From the Thomaston Express, April 9, 1897:*

"A small portion on the west side of the green in Plymouth, given for a meeting-house site, parade ground and burying-ground [by the town of Waterbury and by others, Dec. 3, 1747] was set apart for burial purposes. The ledge of rocks on the south west part prevented its extension toward the south more than two-thirds of the way.

"The first marked grave is that of Lucy, daughter of [Rev.] Samuel Todd who died in 1752, aged 11 years.<sup>1</sup> The stone is a small gray native stone. In later years it has been recut and reset.

"Early in the century the cemetery was nearly all occupied. In 1818 a piece of ground adjoining on the west was purchased of Joseph Wright who lived in a large two-story house near the meeting-house.

"The conditions of the deed were the payment by the town of \$178.12½ and the privilege of using the old and new parts for the pasturing of sheep only as long as he or his wife should live, for two dollars a year.

"Mr. Wright was a prominent man in public affairs, being a member of the Legislature, and the first town-clerk. His was the first marble monument erected in this cemetery.

"Mrs. Bellamy, widow of the noted Dr. Bellamy of Bethlehem, has inscribed on her tombstone the fact that she was the wife of three ministers. She lies by the side of the Rev. Mr. Storrs, who was her second husband.

"This was a common ground for everybody to be buried in. Whenever a member [of the family] of any resident had a place in the ground, space was left near by that families might be located together."

<sup>1</sup> This is an error. Lucy Todd was born Feb. 6, 1751, and died Jan. 9, 1752, aged 11 months.



Thomaston and Plymouth, called Northbury or Up-river, were set off from Waterbury with Westbury Society in 1780, forming Watertown. In 1795, Northbury departed from Watertown and became Plymouth. In 1875, Thomaston was set off from Plymouth. The ancient burial-ground still remains, as it has been for more than one hundred and sixty years, in the rear of the Congregational Church.
